Application for Fire Districts Sustainability One Time Funding and Possible Action:

Discussion was held on items to include in the grant. Funding was suggested for equipment & apparatus, hiring of extra help, and costs for the 218 process. Lynnel will work on the application and circulate to all for input.

Fire Chief's Report:

Assistant Chief Tafoya reported that the District received a CalFire grant in the amount of \$9,229.99 for four sets of structure turn-outs, six sets of wildland turn-outs and four shelters. This will require a 50% match and the volunteers will be asked to cover this cost.
